WATER AND ELECTRICITY

BASIS FOR THE PROPOSED BUDGET

The 2003-04 Proposed Budget for Water and Electricity relates to current year funding as follows:

The Proposed Budget provides funding in the amount of \$9.2 million for water and \$26.21 million for electricity for a total appropriation of \$35.4 million. The budget provides for a net \$.827 million increase from 2002-03. The following changes account for the increase in the Water and Electricity Fund: approximately \$1.1 million in additional water and electricity costs for new facilities, including the Valley and Metro 9-1-1 Police Dispatch Centers and the Marvin Braude San Fernando Valley Constituent Services Center. Funding levels for Educational Opportunities and Lighting of Streets are adjusted sufficiently to accommodate anticipated changes. The funding levels are based upon previous year appropriations and projected requirements for 2003-04.
