


Draft Initial Watershed Plans

- Initial draft released on August 14th, 2025.
 - Public comment period open from August 14th, 2025 to September 28th, 2025
- Overarching Comments Across All LA watershed areas:
 - Need to account for existing projects and nesting between projects (e.g., drainage area overlap)
 - Need to incorporate tools to assist proponents report metrics to the program consistently
 - Need to incorporate additional information from scientific studies (e.g., geographic scope and results)
 - Need more consideration for O&M funding requirements

Rd 7 (FY 26/27) and Rd 8 (FY 27/28) Letters of Non-Objection/Support

- Rd 7 (FY 26/27)
 - Retroactive request - UCLA Mobility, Stormwater Capture, and Greening Project (Metro and UCLA)
- Rd 8 (FY 27/28) - Invitation to Collaborate released on August 1st, 2025.
 - Deadline for collaboration requests on October 31st, 2025
 - Request to date:
 - Green Alleys and Sidewalks in Historic Filipinotown (LANI)
 - Grand Canals - Venice Canals Restoration and Stormwater Project (TBD)



Project Modification Requests (PMRs) - Due Oct 31st

Purpose:


- Notification of proposed significant modifications to Projects, Project concepts, or Studies
- Determine whether or not the modified Project or Study remains consistent or inconsistent with SIP.

Examples of Modifications:

- Change in Funded Activity completion dates
- Reallocation of annual funding projections in the SIP, including requests for additional funding
- Change in scope, methods, BMP type, or benefits claimed

Recommended Approach:

- Get appropriate approvals before submitting “inconsistent” modifications (e.g. AOC approval of additional funding requested in PMRs)
- Be certain about modifications (Avoid serial PMRs)
- Make modifications to stay in good standing (e.g. be transparent with big changes, keep schedule changes in same FY, etc.)
- Propose funding shifts during WASC deliberations instead of PMRs
