Item 2 Recreation and Parks Measure A report requesting retroactive authorization to submit competitive grant applications for Griffith Park, Hanson Dam Recreation Area, Cabrillo Beach Lifeguard Tower, Point Fermin Park, Wilders Addition Park Stairs, and Oakridge Estate project and to accept grant funds if awarded.
