Steven Tran and Matthew Alcedo, Recreation and Parks, presented the report providing a summary of current balances of Categories 1 and 2 annual allocations, maintenance and servicing program, grant applications, and grant status.

Item 3 The Bureau of Engineering Report on the Proposition K Program Griffith Park Ferraro Soccer Fields - Reclaimed Water Scope - Finding of Infeasibility (Proposition K ID# R12).

DISPOSITION Approved.

Ohaji Abdallah, Bureau of Engineering, presented a status update of the completed scope of work and the infeasibility of the reclaimed water portion of the Ferraro Soccer Fields.

Matias Farfan, CLA, asked for clarification whether the \$4.2 million that has been awarded is for Phase I and II. Mr. Abdallah confirmed that the funds are for Phase I and II and any remaining funds related to the reclaimed water portion will be reverted back to the Proposition K.

Mr. Farfan asked what the reclaimed water amount was. Mr. Abdallah stated he will respond back with the dollar amount after the meeting.

Matt Hale, Mayor's Office, asked if the remaining balance to be reverted is restricted only to reclaimed water or similar projects. Mr. Abdallah answered the funds will be reprogrammed to another eligible Proposition K program and will obtain this Committee's approval at a later date.
