Minutes from the Special Meeting of April 10, 2025

The meeting was called to order at 9:30 A.M.

General Public Comment, Multiple Agenda Item Comment.

Henry provided comments on all items and general public comment.

General Public Comment, Multiple Agenda Item Comment, comment period closed.

Item 1 Minutes of the March 27, 2025 Regular Meeting.

DISPOSITION Approved.

Item 2 CAO, CLA and Bureau of Engineering (BOE) recommendation to report on funding recommendations for transmission to Council as part of the forthcoming 2025-26 Proposition K Assessment Report for Program Years 29 through 30 (Fiscal Years 2025-26 through 2026-27):

- a. Bureau of Engineering recommendations for the award of 2024-25 maintenance funding.
- b. Reprogramming actions to the 2024-25 Proposition K Program budget (Program Year 28) and the proposed 2025-26 Two Year Plan for Program Years 29 through 30.
- c. Recommended award of 2024-25 inflation and additional specified “(GAP)” funds.
- d. Recommended 2025-26 A-List of Projects and the 2025-26 Three Year Plan for Program Years 29 through 30.
- e. Recommended allocation of 2025-26 Proposition K Program administrative funds.
- f. Draft Engineer’s Report for Fiscal Year 2025-26 (Year 29).

- g. Resolution and Ordinance of Intention to Levy Assessment for review by Committee and release to Council with Assessment Report for Fiscal Year 2025-26 (Year 29).

DISPOSITION Approved as amended.

Melinda Gejer, CAO, presented the annual Proposition K assessment report with an amendment to Attachment 15 to address emergent funding needs for active projects.

Bernyce Hollins, Mayor, questioned if there was a timeframe for either initiating or declaring infeasibility for the two deferred specified projects with restroom improvements that are opposed by the public. Ms. Gejer responded that the Proposition K management team has proposed an alternative implementation to perform improvements to an existing restroom in the same council district within a mile of the two project sites. Ohaji Abdallah, BOE, added that there would be a neighborhood council meeting scheduled to present the alternative option for feedback.

Ms. Hollins then asked if there were any other projects with barriers to implementation other than funding shortfalls. Ms. Gejer responded there is a long deferred project at the North Hollywood Skate Facility for the installation of a BMX facility. In the prior years, the Department of Recreation and Parks did not allow the use of bicycles on park facilities. The policy has now changed and bicycles are currently allowed.

Ms. Hollins asked that the Proposition K management team check the administrative closeout records to confirm that the portion of the scope was completed in the same vicinity in partnership with a private entity.

The LAFKSC Chair adjourned the meeting at 9:42 A.M.
