Minutes from the Regular Meeting of June 26, 2025

The meeting was called to order at 9:30 A.M.

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General Public Comment, Multiple Agenda Item Comment.

Item 1 Minutes of the April 10, 2025 Special Meeting.

**DISPOSITION** Approved.

Item 2 Department of Recreation and Parks (RAP) report requesting authorization to submit work plan for Sunland Dog Park Project and to accept funds if awarded. (Measure A; Council District 7).

**DISPOSITION** Approved.

Yumi Sangen, RAP, presented the report requesting approval to submit a work plan to request \$1.35 million in Measure A funding for the Sunland Dog Park Project and accept the funds if awarded.

Ivet Madatyan, Mayor, questioned what the operations and maintenance responsibilities would be for the project since the Proposition K program will sunset shortly. Melinda Gejer, CAO, clarified that the project would be funded by Measure A and is not a Proposition K project. Ms. Sangen added that the dog park project would be eligible for Measure A maintenance funding.

Item 3 Office of the City Administrative Officer financial report and findings on the Health Alternatives to Smoking Fund, as required under Government Code Section 66000, et seq., and Los Angeles Administrative Code 5.512. (Healthy Alternatives to Smoking Trust Fund; All Council Districts).

**DISPOSITION** Approved.

Melinda Gejer, CAO, presented the annual report on the status of the Health Alternatives to Smoking Fund.

- Item 4 Bureau of Engineering (BOE) financial report and findings on the Parks First Trust Fund, as required under Government Code Section 66000, et seq., and authorization to transmit to City Council for further action. (Parks First Trust Fund; Council Districts 4, 10, and 13).

**DISPOSITION** Approved.

Ohaji Abdallah, BOE, presented the annual report on the status of the Parks First Trust Fund.

Matias Farfan, CLA, asked if the revenues to the fund are development fees within the specific region. Ms. Gejer confirmed that the fees are from the specific region and added that no additional fees are anticipated due to developers paying the higher Quimby park development fee to RAP.

- Item 5 BOE report requesting approval to extend the contract for the Housing Authority of the City of Los Angeles (HACLA) Mar Vista Gardens Childcare Center Project and to authorize the City Engineer to execute an amendment to the grant agreement in order to extend the contract. (Proposition K ID No. S097) (Proposition K, Council District 11).

**DISPOSITION** Deferred to the Regular LAFKSC meeting on July 31, 2025.
