The meeting was called to order at 2:00 p.m.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: General Public Comment, Multiple Agenda Item Comment

NEIGHBORHOOD COUNCIL COMMENTS: Discussion with Neighborhood Council representative on Neighborhood Council Resolutions or Community Impact Statements filed with the City Clerk which relate to any agenda item listed or being considered on this agenda.

AGENDA ITEMS:

1. Minutes of the September 4, 2025 meeting.

DISPOSITION: Approved.

2. Reports requesting Committee action to approve status updates of street and transportation projects list for Public Works (PW), Bureau of Engineering (BOE):
 - A. Hillside Slope Stability Program (HSSP); and,
 - B. Street Improvement Division (SID).

The Committee received presentations from BOE providing updates on project schedules. New projects were added while some were removed as projects were consolidated.

DISPOSITION: Approved the changes to the project lists.

3. Reports with status updates on street and transportation projects list for Public Works (PW), Bureau of Engineering (BOE):
 - A. Bridge Improvement Division (BID); and,
 - B. Municipal Facilities, Architect, Recreation and Parks and Los Angeles River Division.

The Committee received presentations from BOE providing updates on project schedules.

DISPOSITION: The Committee noted and filed the report.

4. Reports requesting Committee action to approve status updates of street and transportation projects list for Bureau of Street Lighting (BSL).

The Committee received presentations from BSL regarding updates to their project schedules.

DISPOSITION: The Committee noted and filed the report.

5. Reports requesting Committee action to approve status updates of street and transportation projects list for Bureau of Street Services (BSS).

The Committee received presentations from BSS regarding updates to their project schedules. New projects were added as part of the 2025–26 Adopted Budget, while several others were removed due to completion, cancellation, or reassignment to other divisions within the Bureaus or City Departments.

DISPOSITION: Approved.

6. Reports requesting Committee action to approve status updates of street and transportation projects list for Department of Transportation (DOT).

The Committee received presentations from DOT regarding updates to their project schedules.

DISPOSITION: The Committee noted and filed the report.

7. Written report from BOE on the status of the Glendale-Hyperion Complex of Bridges Project. – Action by Committee

Principal Civil Engineer Nadir Shah, and Senior Civil Engineer, Andrew Asfour (BOE), provided the Committee with an overview of the project and recommended that the report be recommended to the Los Angeles City Council, subject to the approval of the Mayor, authorize five (5) full-time resolution authority positions: one (1) Senior Civil Engineer, two (2) Civil Engineers, one (1) Senior Management Analyst I, and one (1) Civil Engineering Associate III, for the period of March 1, 2026, through June 30, 2026. The 2025–26 Adopted Budget allocated \$30 million from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation (SB1) Fund to the Capital Technology Improvement Expenditure Program (CTIEP) for salaries and construction costs. This allocation provides the local match and front-funding for both the Federal Highway Bridge Program Grant and the State Proposition 1B Local Bridge Seismic Retrofit Program Grant.

DISPOSITION: Approved.

8. Verbal report from DOT on the Transportation Grant Fund. – Note and File

Mr. Rios, DOT, provided a verbal report on the condition of the Transportation Grant Fund. Due to a lack of staffing resources in the department's Accounting Section, reimbursements for various grant-funded projects are being billed annually. This has depleted the available cash in the fund. Consequently, the department has submitted a budget request for more accounting positions and an additional cash influx to stabilize the fund's cash flow.

DISPOSITION: The Committee noted and filed the report.

9. Verbal report from DOT on the use Proposition C Salaries as a local match. – Note and File

Mr. Rios, DOT, provided a verbal report on using Proposition C-funded positions as the City's local match when applying for grant funds. Following reductions in the 2025-26 Budget, many Prop C-funded positions were eliminated. Although these positions were ultimately restored, they now receive grant reimbursements. Consequently, they no longer serve as a local match because their costs will be covered by grant funding.

DISPOSITION: The Committee noted and filed the report.
