PUBLIC COMMENT

An opportunity for the public to address the Committee on agenda items for which public hearings have not been held will be provided at the time the item is considered or during the Multiple Agenda Item Comment period. Members of the public who wish to speak on items shall be allowed to speak for up to one minute per item up to a total of three minutes per meeting.

The Committee will also provide an opportunity for the public to speak on public interest items at regular meetings. Each speaker shall be limited to one minute of general public comment at each regular meeting. The Committee shall not discuss or take action relative to any general public comment.

Testimony shall be limited in content to matters which are within the subject matter jurisdiction of the Committee. The Committee may not take any action nor engage in any discussion on matters presented during this general public comment period. The purpose of public comment is to allow the public to address the Committee and the Committee is interested in hearing from members of the public, stakeholders and interested parties. However, speakers are asked to exercise courtesy and consider the rights of other speakers by adhering to the time limits set forth and if possible refrain from unnecessary repetition in their comments. This Committee will take public comment from members of the public in Room 1500 and also by teleconference. Members of the public who wish to offer public comment to this Committee via teleconference should call (1-669-900-6833) and use Meeting ID No. 848 0231 2824 and then press #. Press # again when prompted for Participant ID. Once admitted into the meeting, press *9 to request to speak.
